    - o Discussed summer homework help
    - o SM purchased Brain Fuze through a grant – it was helpful but costly. No need for 1 on 1 – 1-3 students came in per day. In the Fall, starting in September they will have Paws to Read – Love on a Leash program
    - o Carpinteria uses Britannica, Proquest, and National Geographic during Homework Help. Works with The Children's Project. Coordinates directly with the schools to offer more help
  - b. **\*Summer Reading Program**
    - o LOM – Reading Beyond and Beanstack. In person and virtual programs – Sip & Paint, Z-making, Rock Art, Stuffed Animal Campout. Offers Dragon software.
    - o SM – holds stuffed animal campout; hands our sleeping bags and pillowcases that kids can decorate. The stuffed animals get to choose the books. Summer Reading June 1- July 30 for all ages and they work with Equity Building Group to strive to make all programming more equitable. Offers Dragon software. Participants Party – face painting, crafts, therapy dogs. With unexpected funds, they were able to have Peruvian Dancers perform.
