BACKGROUND: Describe why you are bringing this item before council. What problem are you trying to solve? List information that would be helpful for decision making such as committee recommendations, pros/cons.	The withdrawal of prior members of Black Gold has left remaining Black Gold members with a huge obligation to pay the Unfunded Pension Liability for the more than 30 years in which departing members benefited from the service of staff employed by Black Gold Cooperative Library System. Current legislation does not require the withdrawing members to be liable for the obligation unless Black Gold were to terminate its agreement with CalPERS. The result of this is that remaining members must pay the full obligation of the Unfunded Pension Liability, even when the departed members reaped the benefit of the services of the Black Gold employees for 30 years. The result of this is that approx. 60% of the obligation for years 1985-2022 (which rightfully belongs to the departed members) must be paid by the remaining Black Gold members.
