AUTHORIZED PERSONAL NAMES


Names in bibliographic records must be authorized (standardized) to provide uniform access. If the bib record is a fully cataloged record from the Library of Congress, the names in the 100, 600, 700, and 800 fields will be in the authorized form. Records may have <u>un</u>authorized names if:

- 1. If the record is a minimal or brief record, is from Midwest Tape, is a book on CD or other minimal vendor record.
- 2. The bib record was created manually with a template and does not include the authorized name.
- 3. The authorized name of the person has been changed (they died, or initials are spelled out, or other dates or qualifying information have been added).

NOTE: If the record isn't a Library of Congress record, is older than the current year plus 2 years, is a minimal or partial record, or is created manually with a template, please check the 100, 600, 700 and 800 fields to make sure the fields are authorized.

Authorized Names in the OPAC

The name King, Adrienne is an example of a name entered in bib records in both authorized and unauthorized forms. The search in the OPAC results in 2 different name listings: the unauthorized form: King, Adrienne and the authorized form: King, Adrienne, 1960-



To ensure records have authorized names the best option is to accept the full record, whether it is AACR2 or RDA, with authorized names.


Check for Authorized Names

There are three ways to check for the authorized form of a name:

- 1. Authority Records in Polaris
- 2. Authorities in the SkyRiver Client
- 3. Library of Congress Authorities website

Authority Records in Polaris


In Cataloging, search the name in the Authority Records Heading Find Tool to see if an Authority Record exists in Polaris. (There is not an authority record in Polaris for King, Adrienne at this time.)




If there is an authority record, double click the name to open the authority record, and copy and paste the name into your record. Save your record and close the authority record.

SkyRiver Client

To view authorized forms of names in SkyRiver, log into the SkyRiver client, and click Search > Authorities, enter last name, first name, and search by Heading. This will retrieve a list of names:

Copy the name and date from the Authority record and paste it into your record:



Go to the Library of Congress Authorities site http://authorities.loc.gov/ and click Search Authorities, enter last name, first name, and click Name Authority Headings:



Copy the name and date from the Authority record and paste it into your record:

It is correct for names authorized by the Library of Congress with a **Subfield c** term to be used in the **100**, **600**, **700**, **or 800** fields.

Names in RDA Records

In many RDA records the names are authorized as above, but have an added **Subfield e** Relator term. The **Subfield e** term is added to the name by the Library of Congress or original cataloger to explain the relationship between the person and their role with the material:

The names are still searchable by their authorized format, with or without the relator term. Allow the authorized names with the additional **Subfield e** Relator term to appear in the bib records.



NOTE: The authorized name of Norris, Mary‡c(Editor) includes the **Subfield c** term "Editor" as the Title associated with name, and is the authorized form of her name. This is not the same as the **Subfield e** relator term "editor" used when Sherman Alexie is the editor of a work: Alexie, Sherman,‡d1966-‡eeditor.
