- 6. **NEW BUSINESS**
 - a. *M Shared Materials request (SB & SLO)

This item was tabled at the 2.18.22 meeting. SB and SLO would like to plan for staff capacity and would like an answer as to whether the remaining Black Gold libraries would like to form a committee to work towards a solution to sharing materials in FY22 or FY23.

A motion was made to form a committee of jurisdictions interested in sharing items to discuss parameters and guidelines on how to share items to include SLO and SB. 1st NB/ 2nd SJB. Roll call: PR – abstain, SLO – yes, SM – yes, LM – yes, GV - abstain, SB – yes, SP – yes. Approved. 5- 2 abstaining.

ACTION ITEM: JC (SB) will contact interested directors to set a meeting time/place.

b. * M - Fines and Fees After Migration (SB)

SBPL is migrating to a separate catalog on 4/15/22 and leaving the Black Gold Cooperative effective 6/30/22. The Black Gold Cooperative is also migrating to a new catalog. There are many fines and fees that can be migrated to the new catalog. SBPL would like to suggest that all remaining jurisdictions not migrate over fines/fees owed on items belonging to SBPL. Meaning, we will hold your patrons harmless for lost items, etc. We would like to ask that the same be done for items belonging to the remaining jurisdictions that have fees or fines associated with SBPL patrons.

No motion.

ACTION ITEM: GF (BG) will provide a report for the remaining Black Gold libraries detailing fine and fees for SLO and SB. Jurisdictions will be able to decide how to proceed individually. SB and SLO are wiping fines and fees to start with a clean database.

c. * M - Q4 OverDrive Contribution – SLO (BG)

The contribution for the Shared eContent & Subscription Services is determined as part of our annual budget process and agreed upon by all members. According to the JPA, Council determines the total contribution for the forthcoming year and the share of the total that shall be contributed by each member agency. Contributions shall be payable in equal installments quarterly. There are no provisions in the JPA for not paying the agreed upon contributions

A motion was made for SLO to pay the agreed platform fee and to move the Black Gold Overdrive collection to the Palace Project. 1st CB/ 2^{nd} JC. Roll call: PR – no, SLO – yes, SM – no, LM – no, GV - no, SB – yes, SP – no. Defeated 2-5.

A motion was made for SLO and SB to pay the agreed their 4th quarter platform fee but no content fees. 1st NB/ 2nd CB. Roll call: PR – yes, SLO – yes, SM – yes, LM – yes, GV - yes, SB – yes, SP – yes. Approved. 7-0

d. * M - Actuary to study Unfunded Pension Liability (BG)

The Unfunded Accrued Pension liability is currently approx. \$760,000. The Hypothetical Unfunded Pension Termination liability is approx. \$5,500,000. With 2 members of the JPA exiting June 30, 2022, we need to address how this liability will be divided among all existing members (including those exiting). Black Gold would like to contract with an actuary to study the CalPERS Unfunded Pension Liability and to ultimately recommend to the members and their governing bodies a fair distribution of the liability. Glynis has already spoken with a couple of actuaries about this issue at a cursory level and they have both preliminarily quoted \$5,000-\$7,000 depending on the scope of work. The study will take at least a month to complete.

A motion was made to approve an additional \$7,000 for an actuarial study on the unfunded CalPERS pension liability as a reimbursable. 1st NB/ 2nd AF. Roll call: PR – yes, SLO – no, SM – yes, LM – yes, GV - yes, SB – no, SP – yes. Approved. 5-2.

e. *M -2022-23 Preliminary Budget

A motion was made to approve the Preliminary Budgets with the following adjustments: renew Capira contract for 6 months; potential increase in Overdrive budget. 1st NB/ 2nd AG. Roll call: PR – yes, SLO – abstain, SM – yes, LM – yes, GV - yes, SB – abstain, SP – yes. Approved. 5-2 abstaining

DISCUSSION NOTES: SLO and SB will not be using Capira as of April 1st. AF (PR) would like to add the possibility of BG jurisdictions using Overdrive Advantage Plus to a

future meeting. SB and SLO will decide concerning their Luna collections later and will remain in the Black Gold Luna collection for the time being.

- f. *Informational SB and SLO withdrawal from Black Gold official notification to CLSB DISCUSSION NOTES: This is an official notification for the Library Services Board.
- g. M-Decide to hold a (AB 361) virtual meeting as allowed by Gov. Code § 54953 (e) (1) option C which states: The legislative body holds a meeting during a proclaimed state of emergency and has determined, by majority vote, pursuant to subparagraph (B) that, as a result of the emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health and safety of attendees.

1st SJB/ 2nd NB. Roll call: PR – yes, SLO – yes, SM – yes, LM – yes, GV - yes, SB – yes, SP – yes. Approved. 7-0

7. BLACK GOLD OPERATIONS DIRECTOR REPORT

GF (BG) reported that she is currently working with Cenic to finalize contracts for the coming year. It largely depends on whether SLO and SB will remain with BG or not. Without SLO and SB the discount is 84%, Cenic proposes a 74% discount if they stay for a limited time. The regular discount would be 60% otherwise. We need a commitment from SB and SLO to proceed at this point. The deadline for filing is 03/22/22. JC (SB) asked if GF (BG) could put the breakdown and proposal into writing so she could review it and decide by Monday (03/21/22). CB (SLO) state that SLO intends to remain under the BG connections until they can secure their own equipment. He asked that GF (BG) provide him with a written proposal, so that he can move forward. SB IT tech was looking at options, JC (SB) would connect with them to see what SB would decide about their Cenic plans.

NB (SP) asked about the potential for early termination fees. GF (BG) explained that there are early termination fees, but should SB decide to keep Eastside connected to Black Gold until 07/01/23, the fees would decrease by \$25,000. The question of whether Montecito still planned to separate from SB could affect whether they should stay on the Black Gold connection was brought up. JC(SB) stated that there was no date for a Montecito separation at this time. JC (SB) stated that the discussion of the early termination fees was a separate issue to be discussed at the Black Gold level and was not part of the decision to remain under the BG Cenic contract at this time.

JC (SB) requested a copy of the Carpinteria MOU be shared at the Admin Council's next meeting.
