

## Black Gold VPN Instructions

1. Open your favorite browser and browse to Pavpn.blackgold.org
2. Type in your Polaris username and password as seen below.

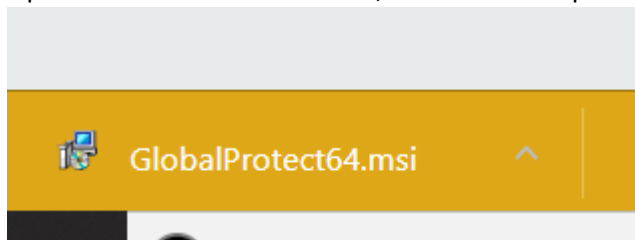

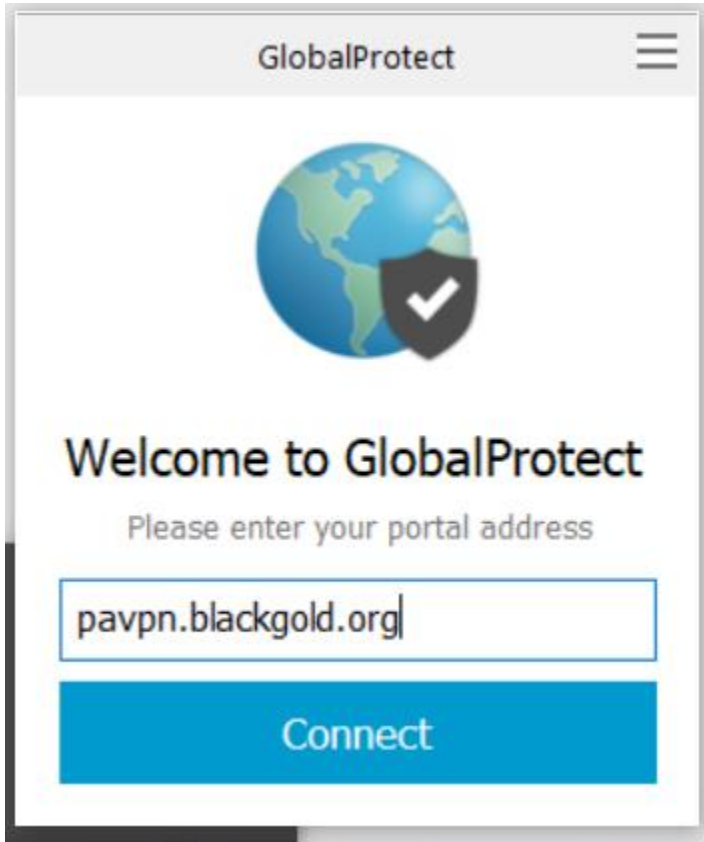


4. Open the downloaded installer, here's an example from Chrome

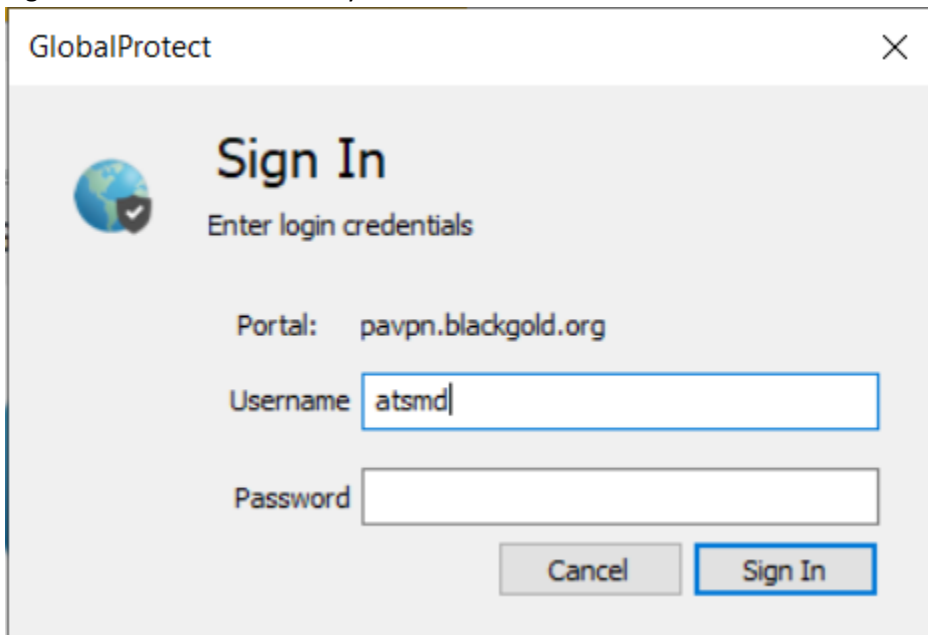


5. Install GlobalProtect by following all of the prompts by hitting next.

6. Once installed type in the vpn portal address as seen below.



7. Sign into GlobalProtect with your Polaris credentials as seen below.



8. You can verify you are connected by looking for the world icon on the bottom righthand corner of the screen with a check mark on it. If you don't see it, hit the ^ symbol and you can find the icon in that menu.



9. Once connected you can use RDP, hard client or LEAP depending on your daily operation.
10. Once you're done in Polaris, find the world icon again and click it.



11. Choose disconnect to disconnect from the VPN.
